Its body is black and yellow. It has a very long neck and long legs.

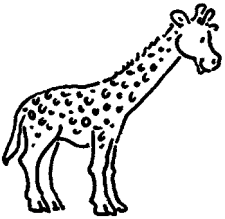
Rick
