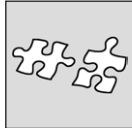

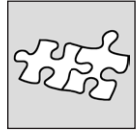

|---------------------------|---|---|--|
| (to) tidy up |  | <p>Imagine your room is a mess. What do you have to do to make it nice again?</p> | <p>The action of putting things where they belong (= <i>hingehören</i>).</p> |
| (to) Hoover the floor |  | <p>To use a machine to get rid of (= <i>beseitigen</i>) the dust (= <i>Staub</i>) on the floor.</p> | <p>Before you clean a floor with water, you usually need to do this job.</p> |
| (to) dust |  | <p>To clean furniture with a soft cloth (= <i>Tuch</i>).</p> | <p>For this job you need a stick (= <i>Stiel</i>) with a feathery (= <i>fedrig</i>) end to clean furniture, for example.</p> |
| (to) empty the dishwasher |  | <p>There is a machine in the kitchen which cleans dirty plates, cups, knives etc. You have to do this when everything is clean.</p> | <p>The action of taking clean plates, cups, knives etc. out of a machine.</p> |
| (to) lay the table |  | <p>Before you can have a meal, you need to put different things on the table. That's why your mother asks: "Can you please ... ?"</p> | <p>To put plates, glasses, knives and forks on a table before you have a meal.</p> |

| (to) walk the dog |  | Dogs can't use a litter box (= Katzenklo) like cats. That's why you have to do this job. | To put a leash (= Leine) on the collar (= Halsband) of a dog and take it outside. |
| (to) dry dishes |  | After washing the plates, cups, glasses etc. in a sink (= Waschbecken), you have to do this job. | To rub plates, cups, glasses etc. dry (= trockenreiben) with a cloth (= Tuch) before you put them in a cupboard. |
| (to) take out the rubbish |  | When the rubbish bin (= Mülleimer) in the house is full, this job needs to be done. | It's what your parents tell you when they want you to empty the rubbish bin (= Mülleimer). |
| (to) water the plants |  | Plants as well as humans need water to survive. The job you need to do is ... | In class there are duties like cleaning the board or handing out worksheets. Your duty is to take care of the plants. What do you do? |
| (to) hang up the washing |  | You have to do this to dry the laundry (= Wäsche). | To put your wet shirts, trousers, socks etc. on a clothes line (= Wäscheleine). |
